ACT

The Education Directorate funds the Safe and Inclusive School Initiative to provide a range of supports to schools to develop their practice in areas such as supporting individual student need, welcoming and celebrating community and family diversity.

The Initiative supports schools to build respectful school cultures where prejudice, discrimination, harassment and violence on the basis of gender presentation/identity, intersex status or sexual orientation is unacceptable.

The Initiative provides schools and education programs:

Professional Learning Programs and other targeted training and information sessions

- Guidance for the identification and use of relevant high-quality teaching and learning resources and materials
- Provision of expert advice and support for schools
- Supporting leadership opportunities for students, staff and parents/carers

In the ACT, the Education Directorate has the <u>Safe and Supportive Schools Policy</u> that provides guidance for Canberra public schools on promoting a safe, respectful and supportive school community. They are currently in the process of developing additional resources to provide good advice to schools to support young people who wish to affirm their gender at school.
